Student Selection and Placement System (ÖSYS) Exams YGS/LYS	To have the base point from YGS/LYS of the previous year in the program applied.
SAT Reasoning	<p>Undergraduate Programs: For all the faculties; It's required to have at least 1100 total points over 1600 points from the "Math" and "Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (Critical Reading in older version)" sections. For the Engineering, Architecture, Dentistry, Pharmacy and Science Faculties (College of Science); it's required to get at least 660 points in "Math" section over 800 points. For Medical Faculty, it's required to have at least 1200 total points over 1600 points in "Math" and "Critical Reading" sections of SAT Reasoning and at least 700 points in "Math".</p> <p>Associate Programs: It's required to get at least 1000 total points over 1600 from Math and Critical Reading sections of SAT Reasoning; and for the Health Science Vocational High School, Technical Sciences Vocational High School and Computer Programming, it's required to get at least 600 point over 800 points in "Math" section.</p>
ACT Exam	<p>Undergraduate Programs: For Medical Faculty, it's required to get at least 30 points over 36; for the Engineering, Architecture, Science Faculties (Collage of Science) it is required to have 28 points over 36; for other faculties 24 points over 36 is required.</p> <p>Associate Programs: For the Health Science Vocational High School, Technical Sciences Vocational High School and Computer Programming, it's required to have 22 points over 36 total points. For other faculties, 20 points is required.</p>
Cambridge International GCE- AL/ASL Exams	<p>Undergraduate Programs: At least one A grade from two A levels of the applied programs; A level notes being: A*=140, A=120, B=100, C= 80 and a total of 320 points from a calculation made by adding the half of the obtained points together from AS level grades different from A levels.</p> <p>Associate Programs: At least one B grade from two A levels of the applied programs; A level notes being: A*=140, A=120, B=100, C= 80 and a total of 280 points from a calculation made by adding the half of the obtained points together from AS level grades different from A levels.</p> <p>NOTE: Candidates who intending to apply with GCE AL or AS Level grades, will not be accepted by estimated scores.</p>
